Waterwheel Art in the Park

Will Case stated that a sculpture created by Bob Sweney was placed in Waterwheel Park a number of years ago. Prior to construction, the sculpture was removed. He would like to see the sculpture placed back in the park along with a couple more pieces that could be added. Karl Bahle would like to see a moratorium on any art placed in the park until we see how the park is being utilized. Manager Larrea stated that there are other parks that could be the right site for art as well. Committee is recommending that council wait to make a decision on Art in the Park until we see how the park is being utilized.

Manager Larrea stated that the Administrative Committee will be looking at an amendment to the manager's Ordinance that would give the Village Manager the authority to purchase items up to an amount of five-thousand dollars (\$5,000) and to execute contracts for services up to the amount of eight-thousand dollars (\$8,000). They will also be reviewing updates to the Employee Handbook which were previously discussed in May.
